PLASTIC BOTTLES & JUGS

All plastic containers have an identification code stamped on the bottom. Different types of plastic are identified by the number inside the "chasing arrows". In Joplin, #1 and #2 type plastic bottles, with necks, clear or colored (except brown), can be recycled. Remove lids, rinse and flatten. Containers that held toxins (drain cleaner, automotive fluids, etc.) will not be accepted. To dispose of toxins, see flip side of this brochure under Recycling Center-new Household Hazardous Waste category.

RESIDENTIAL TRASH SERVICE RULES

- ◇ The City manages the Residential Trash Service through Allied Waste Services for every house, duplex and (approved) apartment houses that have an "activated" water meter. If the water is "turned on" but the living unit is "unoccupied", a trash bill will still be charged.
- ◇ The charge of \$6.98 will be on each household's water bill plus a \$.35 monthly billing fee. Look for "Joplin Garbage Collection" charge total of **\$7.33** on your water bill.
- ◇ To learn what day of the week your **Trash Pick-Up Day** is scheduled for, call Allied Waste Services or the City.
- ◇ Trash collection starts at **6:00 AM**. Place trash cans at curb/alley no earlier than 12 hours before collection day, and please remove cans within 12 hours after collection.
- ◇ Optional **Roll-Out Carts** are rented directly from Allied Waste Services for **\$3.50** per month.
- ◇ **Handicapped** residents may call the City at 624-0820 Ext. 501 to arrange for door service.
- ◇ **Landlords with rentals** need to call the City at 624-0820 Ext. 560 for an explanation of the billing procedures.
- ◇ Trash will be picked up a day late (using Sat. to catch up) on the following **holidays, unless the holiday falls on a weekend**: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.
- ◇ **Extreme Weather** can also affect trash schedule.

Joplin Residents and Joplin Residential Landlords on the city's residential trash service (with approved I.D.) may take acceptable items to the transfer station for FREE. For dwellings that are part of the city's residential trash service, *bulky items may also be set out with the weekly trash pickup.* BELOW IS A PARTIAL LIST OF CURBSIDE BULKY ITEMS RULES:
