

The Carl Junction City Council met in special session on Friday, April 28, 2006 at 10:00 AM at City Hall. Those present were: Mayor Moss, Richard Zaccardelli, Carl Skaggs, Pat Smith, Dee Lynn Davey, and Walter Hayes. Also present was City Clerk Maribeth Matney and Chief Delmar Haase.

**OPENING OF BIDS**

Chief Haase opened the police car bids. There were as follows:

Carthage Ford \$21047 with a trade in of \$2700  
Olathe Ford \$21911 with a trade in of \$1500  
Friendly Ford \$20988 with a trade in of \$2200

Chief Haase opened the SUV bids. They were as follows:  
Carthage Ford – new SUV - \$21488 with a trade in of \$2500  
Used SUV - \$18100

Friendly Ford – new SUV - \$21495.91 with a trade in of \$1800

Carl Skaggs motioned to accept the Carthage Ford bid of \$21047 with a trade in of \$2700 for our police cars. Richard Zaccardelli seconded. All in favor. No opposed. It was stated that we can wait on the SUV until the council meeting on Tuesday.

Chief Haase then opened the car video system bids. There were as follows:  
ICOP - \$34088.98 for Option 1; \$37126.74 for Option 2.
