**APPROVE A LIQUOR BY THE DRINK LICENSE FOR MYTHOS' EURO**

The City Clerk has received a liquor license application for Mythos's Euro. They are catering a benefit golf tournament on 5/15/07. We have talked to the new owner's of Briarbrook and explained that they need to look at their calendar to alert the caterers that it takes about 3-4 weeks for a liquor license approval. It takes the State 4-10 days to process applications and depending on when it falls between our council meetings it could take up to 4 weeks. We will follow up in writing the conversation we had regarding this matter. Pat Smith motioned to approve the liquor license. Richard Zaccardelli seconded. All in favor. No opposed. It was discussed changing the code to allow the staff to approve the licenses instead of coming before the council. It was suggested that we have the Mayor, City Administrator and City Clerk be able to approve with 2 out of the 3 signing off on it. Pat Smith suggested that the attorney draw up a draft to change the code.
